

CONSENT AND RELEASE AGREEMENT

(Please READ thoroughly)

This form is designed to give information needed to make an informed decision of whether or not to undergo a Permanent Make-Up application. If you have questions, please don't hesitate to ask.

Although permanent make-up is effective in most cases, no guarantee can be made that a specific client will benefit from the procedure.

This is the process of inserting pigment into the dermal layer of skin and is a form of tattooing.

All instruments that enter the skin or come in contact with the body fluids are disposable and disposed of after each use. Cross-contamination guidelines are strictly adhered to. Safety is of the utmost importance.

Generally, the results are excellent. However, a perfect result is not a realistic expectation. It is typical to expect a touch-up after the first session of healing is complete. Sometimes an additional touchup is needed - it just depends how well your skin accepts the pigment.

Initially the color will appear much more vibrant or darker compared to the end result. Usually within 5-7 days the color will fade 20%-30%, soften, and look more natural. The initial crisp lines "fuzz" as the pigment is absorbed into the skin. The pigment is considered permanent, however, it will fade over time and will likely need to be touched-up within 1-2 years for brows, and 2-3 years for lips. Please note that color may fade faster on oily skin - please refer to the Policy Section.
